The system must be easy to use and intuitive, enabling users to work in the most efficient way. This means customizing the system to meet unique requirements and workflows, and automating and simplifying in order to eliminate unnecessary clicks.



### ROUTING & REVIEW

Ensure the right applications are routed to the right people and to provide tools for efficient review, in order to keep everyone in the process both nimble and focused.



### WORKFLOW CUSTOMIZABILITY

Processes should be streamlined in a centralized solution, providing flexibility for meeting the individual needs of regional teams, departments and other functional groups.



### BUDGETING & FULFILLMENT

The system must be able to capture current budgets for real time reporting. It should integrate with your payment system to ensure proper approval, reducing steps and potential for error.



### IMPACT REPORTING & QUERYING

Efficient decision making and impact measurement relies on a robust set of reporting capabilities. The system must be able to capture necessary data in the right format, and to quickly query the system and generate reports with a single click.
